Autism Spectrum Disorder (Autism or ASD) is a neurodevelopmental condition that impacts on child development in a number of key areas including **communication**, **social interaction** and **repetitive patterns of behaviour**. Autism is frequently associated with sensory sensitivities and sensory processing difficulties.
